- Fitting in (Accepting and embracing differences)
- Empathy (Accepting and embracing differences continued)
- Leadership Skills (Ways to be a leader in class and in the community)
- Personal hygiene expectations

The cost of the group is \$40 per meeting.

Participation in each session must be confirmed by the Wednesday prior to the session.

You may pay for the entire 4 weeks at a reduced rate of \$35 per meeting (total of \$140).
